


This term, we will be learning about 'Nature'.

Key Information

- -A caterpillar sheds its skin several times.
- -Butterflies taste with their feet.
- -Butterflies live for around 2-4 weeks.
- -Frogspawn (eggs) are laid in a group.
- -A grags life cycle takes between 12 to 16 weeks.
- -Frogs have ears just behind their eyes.
- -Hens incubate eggs by sitting on them to keep them warm.
- -Chicks use their beak to get out of the egg.
- -Chickens have their own language of over 30 chicken sounds.
- -It takes around 90 days for a sunflower to be fully grown.
- -When a sunflower dies, the seeds fall from its head into the ground.
